Approved in February 2020 | Refreshed in March 2021

Strategic Direction
Continuously monitor the implementation of the GPI Action Plan 2.030, including an annual refresh.
Develop a GPI Annual Report with voluntary annexed contributions (data/case studies) on implementation of the BAPA+40 Outcome Document on triangular cooperation (TrC).
Continuously communicate with GPI members and continue to grow GPI membership with all development stakeholders, including private sector, think tanks and civil society organizations.
Governance Structure
Regularly adapt the GPI governance structure and Concept Note.
Maintain a clear governance structure of the GPI, under coordination of a GPI Focal Point, with regular meetings of GPI core group members, and Advocacy, Analytical and Operational Workstreams.
Organise a General Assembly for the GPI members, in a biennial International GPI Forum on Effective Triangular Cooperation (e.g. Intersessional to the UN High Level Committee on South-South Cooperation).
Operationalizing
Promote a space for matchmaking among GPI members, to identify and facilitate TrC initiatives.
Support the implementation of the Voluntary Guidelines on Effective TrC (VG), including gathering data on how GPI stakeholders are implementing the VG.
Promote knowledge sharing on effective TrC projects in and across different regions and across different modalities (e.g. standalone technical cooperation projects, training, funds, components of larger programmes, etc.).
Share operational guidelines and toolkit from GPI members on an online and open-source inclusive library.
Communication & knowledge management
Continuously monitor the GPI internal and external communication strategy to facilitate communication with GPI members and to share updates across GPI Workstreams and with development stakeholders beyond the GPI membership, including through social media.
